THEME

Resilience and sustainability of farms and agricultural systems in the EU are a complex topic with multi-disciplinary dimensions. Assuring the resilience and sustainability of EU farms in the present global system are important concerns in recent years, in the academic environment, at the governmental level and among farmers across Europe. At the same time, if we look to the future, these themes are found in EU strategies and policies aimed at stimulating a competitive level of development for agriculture, comparable with other sectors.

OBJECTIVES

The seminar will bring together European agricultural economists with an interest in resilience and sustainability of the farming systems in the EU. It aims to evaluate the present state of resilience and sustainability of the farms in the EU and the ways the farmers are dealing with recent economic, environmental and social challenges and opportunities. The seminar will seek for a better design of the future CAP main directions, for elaboration of suggestions and proposals, in order to mitigate the negative influences identified from the experience of the participants on the resilience of farms in the EU, bringing face to face the ideas of the researchers and private and public stakeholders. The papers and posters that will be presented, the comments and discussions among the participating specialists will facilitate the exchange of ideas and will help identifying the best solutions for the future of farms and farming systems in the EU.

TOPICS

- Assessment of farm and farming system resilience
- The role of agricultural risk management towards resilience
- The contribution of public and private policies towards sustainability and resilience
- The influence of farm demographics including labour markets on resilience of farming systems
- The impact of environmental risks on resilience and sustainability of farms
- How CAP post 2020 could address the sustainability and resilience of farming systems in the EU

CALL FOR PAPERS AND POSTERS

We invite you to participate and present your research, papers or posters. An extended abstract, in English, of maximum 1000 words must be submitted until April 20, 2019 (extended deadline).

On the first page, the abstract should include the author(s) name(s), affiliations, and full addresses, the e-mail of the corresponding author, and indicate whether the submission is for paper or poster.

The abstract should indicate: objectives and research questions, theoretical framework, methodology and data used, main results obtained. Authors of accepted abstracts will be notified by May 10, 2019. The deadline for the final submission of accepted papers is August 31, 2019.

The official language of the Seminar is English.
